Each year as part of its mission, Trinity Youth Group in Solebury has embraced working in Philadelphia's high need areas to improve the quality of the residents' lives. The desire to increase the group's efforts toward this mission led to the creation of Lobsterfest as a fundraising vehicle in 1995 and Mission Philadelphia in 1996.

In the last nine years many lives have been touched in a wonderful way both at Trinity and in the neighborhoods they have reached! Mission Philadelphia forges relationships within these neighborhoods, working together to breaking down racial and demographic barriers.

### Here's a Sample of What Generous Support has Helped to Achieve!

- General renovation of shelters and teen centers
- Construction and landscaping of a playground at Hissey Park in North Philadelphia
- Creation and painting of murals at the St. Barnabus Homeless Shelter
- Painting and construction at the Frederick Douglas Christian Academy in Chester
- Transformation of abandoned Philadelphia properties into gardens and community centers
- Strengthening relationships – taking at-risk youth and children to the Philadelphia Zoo, Sesame Place and area parks
- Spiritual support – ecumenical worship services at the Seamen's Institute and a juvenile detention center
- Building humanistic bridges and creating collaborative interactions to improve community environments.

### We're excited about this year's project!

Trinity Youth Group of Trinity Church Solebury has committed to two particularly ambitious projects this year. First, they plan to purchase and install a play system for Overbrook Elementary School, located at 2032 N 62nd Street, Philadelphia PA. The Trinity Youth Group will partner on this project with the African Episcopal Church of St. Thomas, the Overbrook Farms Community Association, Overbrook Presbyterian and Lancaster Avenue Redevelopment Corporation (LARC). Secondly, the group wishes to create a children's farm at Conestoga and Vine Streets. Both of these projects are located in West Philadelphia.

### How Does This Get Done?

For the past nine years, the Trinity Youth Group has been spending a week in Philadelphia's inner city working on these community projects. These youth members donate their time and effort to help those less fortunate than themselves. They build relationships within each community by engaging local adults and children in every aspect of their mission. In 2006, the group will continue these worthy efforts for the 10th year!
